**COVID-19 Exposure Event and Confidentiality Guidelines**  
**08 September 2020**

In the event of a suspected exposure to COVID-19 in the context of any FPC activity, the event host should contact the Church Office as soon as possible. They should consult with church leadership including representatives of the Re-Entry Task Force re: exposure circumstances and risk mitigation procedures.

Risk mitigation procedures include restricting access to the FPC Campus Facilities, deep cleaning physical spaces as needed and prohibition of people who are exposed or actively ill from participation in FPC events until recovered from any illness and/or released from isolation/quarantine.

Specific Risk Mitigation Steps:

Establish contact with the Alamance County Health Department (336-227-0101) for situation specific recommendations with regard to exposure risk assessment. This should include ascertaining whom should be tested, whom should be tested and whom should remain isolated for a 14 day interval.

Notify everyone at risk of exposure using the event participant list or other resources affording complete ascertain of all at risk. Share with them plans for risk mitigation at FPC as well as guidelines for how they should react/behave personally for the foreseeable risk interval (usually 14 days).

Undertake any sanitizing, deep cleaning activities recommended by the health department or the RETF.

Confidentiality:

Identities of individuals involved in any exposure situation will remain confidential. FPC Staff, Re-Entry Task Force members and any others who may have knowledge of event circumstances are to protect identities of people involved in an exposure event while at the same time ensuring that clear information is communicated to those exposed about what their next steps should be.

***Failure to follow these guidelines will result in prohibition of participation in subsequent FPC activities.***
